

 All players and spectators must abide by Bowdon social distancing rules:

- No hugging @ hockey
- Respect current Greater Manchester rules
- Minimise physical contact
- Keep apart when you can
- Be responsible!
- Car-park closed due to building works being carried out.
- •Staggered start times on each pitch to reduce congestion.
- •No arrivals before agreed Arrival Time. Normally, no more than 45 mins before PB. Stay in your car if required.
- •Players/Coaches etc (only) to go directly to their Team Zones to be screened and checked-in. They must stay here until directed onto pitch
- •Use hand sanitiser on arrival you should have your own supply.
- •No pitch access until previous match has left the pitch.
- ·Use one-way system where available.
- No cross-over between pitches.
- •15 minutes allowed in Team Zones after match for team-talk and cool down.
- •Leave site promptly taking all your rubbish and belongings with you.
- Leave everything and everywhere exactly as you found it.
- Use hand sanitiser as you leave the site (your own).
  If you do not respect Bowdon's Covid related requirements, you may be asked to leave.

## **BEFORE SATURDAY**

- Make sure you have checked the timings of other matches before and after your match at the Devisdale and understand where you are in the schedule.
- If you are the first match on that day check with Howard Bray what time school will allow you to access the site safely and in line with their requirements.
- Make sure you have sent the necessary instructions to the opposition.
- Agree an arrival time with the opposition and make sure that they understand they may not arrive early and should stay in their cars until the agreed time.
- Make sure your team know the arrival time and have all the necessary instructions.
- Remind everyone there are no toilets on site
- Make sure you know which pitch you are playing on.

## **ON SATURDAY**

- If you are the first match someone needs to collect the keys from the Club keys behind the bar
- Unlock the car park and pedestrian gates but leave the leave the car park gate closed
- Unlock the gates for the pitch you are playing on and make sure someone holds the keys to pass on to a responsible person for the next match arriving.
- Make sure you have suitable gate-keepers in place ready and understand where you are going to direct your home and away teams both pre and post match.
- Use the map to direct and marshall teams and spectators. Adjust things if needed
- There must be no hockey balls used on the netball courts nor any weeing in the bushes. If either of these happen the whole team will be asked to leave immediately as it may jeopardise our lease with the school.
- At the end of the game get both the teams off the pitch as soon as possible and into their post match zones.
- If you are the last match make sure you lock every gate behind you and either pass the keys to the other match if still playing, or if you are the last match, return the keys to the bar at the Club.
